## Clean Water Act- Pretreatment 33 USC § 1319 (A)

- Any Person Who
- Negligently or Knowingly
- Violates Section
- 1311, 1312, 1316, 1317, 1318, 1321(b)(3), 1328, or 1345

or

## Clean Water Act- Pretreatment 33 USC § 1319 (A)

Any permit condition or limitation

or

Any requirement imposed in a pretreatment program or in a permit

# Clean Water Act- Pretreatment 33 USC § 1319 (B)

- Any Person Who
- Knowingly
- Introduces into a sewer system or POTW
- Any Pollutant or Hazardous Substance
- Which such person knew or reasonably should have known could cause personal injury or property damage

# Clean Water Act- Pretreatment 33 USC § 1319 (B)

- Other than in compliance with all permits
- Which causes POTW to violate any effluent limitation or condition in a permit issued to the POTW

### Penalty

 A fine not less than \$5,000 nor more than \$50,000 per day

and/or

Prison for not more than 3 years

\*2<sup>nd</sup> Offense- \$100,000 per day/6 years

### Clean Water Act- Knowing Endangerment

- Same as above...
- And who knows at that time that he thereby places another person in imminent danger of death or serious bodily injury

Penalty- Up to \$1/4 million/15 years prison

#### Clean Water Act- False Statements

- Any person who
- Knowingly
- Makes a false material statement, representation, or certification in any application, record, plan or other document filed or maintained under the act

or

#### Clean Water Act- False Statements

 Falsifies, tampers with, or renders inaccurate any monitoring device or method required to be maintained under the Act
