

IU Inventory and Characterization

Regulatory Background

40 CFR 403.8(f)(2)(*i-iii*)

- Identify and locate all possible IUs
 - i. Develop and maintain an IU inventory
- ii. Identify the character and volume of pollutants
 - Characterize the IUs on the inventory
- iii. Notification of IUs of applicable Pretreatment Standards – *IUs and SIUs*

Regulatory Background

40 CFR 403.8(f)(2)(vii)

 "Investigate instances of noncompliance with Pretreatment Standards and Requirements, as indicated in the reports and notices required under §403.12, or indicated by analysis, inspection, and surveillance activities described in this section. Sample taking and analysis and the collection of other information shall be performed with sufficient care to produce evidence admissible in enforcement proceedings or in judicial actions."

Regulatory Background

40 CFR 403.8(f)(6)

 "The POTW shall prepare and maintain a list of its Industrial Users meeting the criteria in §403.3(v)(1).

Pretreatment Standards

 Three-Tiered Approach for "significance" or "need for regulatory control" based on the Pretreatment Standards

- National General/Specific Prohibitions
- National Categorical Regulations
- Local Limits

Significant Industrial User

40 CFR 403.3(v)(1)

- Subject to Federal categorical standards
- Discharges 25,000 gpd or more of process wastewater
- Contributes 5 % or more of hydraulic or organic capacity of the POTW treatment plant
- Has a reasonable potential for adversely affecting the POTW or for violating any standard or requirements
 - POTW includes Collection System

Industrial Waste Survey

- Industrial User Inventory and Characterization
- Notification

 No prescriptive procedures in the General Pretreatment Regulations - 40 CFR Part 403

Development/Maintenance of the IU inventory

- Characterize the service area
- Coordination with other Local/County depts.
 - Building/Engineering
 - Community Development
 - Fire/Police
 - Code Enforcement

Challenges with Outside Contributing Jurisdictions

Procedures for Maintaining IU Inventory

- Develop priority IUs or Sectors
 - Dependent on size of POTW or collection system in service area
- Determine appropriate frequencies for updated information for these priority IUs
- Can outside contributing jurisdictions play a larger role with maintenance of the IU inventory?


