



WHEREAS, the NORTH DAVIS SEWER DISTRICT (DISTRICT) pursuant to the powers, duties and responsibilities vested in the District Manager by provisions of the District's Wastewater Control Ordinance (Ordinance) has conducted an on-going investigation of the Respondent and has determined that:

- A. The District owns and operates a wastewater treatment plant and collection facilities which are adversely impacted by discharges from industrial users, including Respondent, and has implemented a pretreatment program to control and regulate such discharges.
- B. Respondent has consistently violated the pollutant limits in its Industrial Discharge Permit (Permit) as set forth in Exhibit 1, attached hereto, or otherwise violated the Ordinance

Therefore, to ensure that Respondent is brought into compliance with its Permit at the earliest possible date, IT IS HEREBY AGREED AND ORDERED, BETWEEN RESPONDENT AND THE DISTRICT as follows:

- 1. [Set forth terms of Agreement as appropriate]
- 2. In the event Respondent fails to comply with any of the deadlines set forth, Respondent shall within one (1) working day after the expiration of the deadline, notify the District in writing. This notice shall describe the reasons for Respondent's failure to comply, the additional amount of time needed to complete the remaining work, and the steps to be taken to avoid future delays. This notification in no way excuses Respondent from its responsibility to meet such or any later milestones required by this Consent Order.






- Does your City Council, Board of Trustees, etc. support the program?

Criteria For Industrial User Awards

No violation for one year
 No violation for two years
 No violation for three years
 No violation for four years
 No violation for five years
 Year certificate
 Year certificate
 Year certificate
 Year plaque

After any violation the process and time begins again.

For six to ten years with no violation, the Industrial User receives a 6-year, 7-year, 8-year, or 9-year certificate as the case may be, then a 10-year plaque for ten years with no violations.
